

DOUBLE COLA

We send you a bottomless pop can, two covers and two glasses. One of the glasses is painted.

Preparation: On a tray you have the nested covers over the painted glass loaded with silks. The other glass contains water and is covered with the can.

Presentation: Call attention to the pop can. Lift off one of the nested covers, show it empty, and drop it over the pop can. Lift the can up and out of this cover, and then drop it down inside the other cover. Then lift that cover up and off the can and show it empty. Drop it back over the can and then remove the can and place it to one side. You have now shown both covers empty.

Lift one cover to reveal the UNcola (the glass of water to be called 7UP). Then produce the silks from the other cover. Nest the other cover over that one and pour water into the nested covers. The water actually goes into the painted glass. Pour enough water in so that the water comes to the top edge of the painted section. Lift the nested covers to reveal a glass of coke.

With the water to the top of the painted section, it is a perfect imitation of coke.
