

P A N D O R A

THE BOX OF A THOUSAND WONDERS

RELEASED BY U.F. GRANT.

PANDORA comes to you all set to go... Look into the box from the rear and note how a rope is threaded thru same with a card on it... Now turn box around so door is to the front and you are all set for a series of four clever rope tricks, of the spirit nature.

1) One hand holds top cover down as other pulls front cover up which will catch and hold there in position.. This action has switched the center of the real rope for a fake center with no card on, show rope in center to be ordinary... Force a duplicate of the card and punch a hole in center with a pencil and place on floor of cabinet... Close front door, then turn cabinet around, so opening is to audience and they now see the card threaded on the rope, grasp rope at center and pull free of cabinet and let anyone remove rope from card.

2) Now with back of cabinet still facing audience, thread rope thru cabinet again and turn cabinet so door is at front, open door and they still apparently see center of rope, cut this in half, close door and turn cabinet with opening to audience and they see rope restored.. Pull rope out and hand for examination.

3) Now using any rope cut method, they apparently cut rope in middle and you tie the apparent ends of rope together and then thread rope in cabinet so knot is at center, turn cabinet around and command spirits to untie the knots... Open front door and show center of rope in two pieces, knots are gone.

4) Close front door and take hold of rope at one outside end of cabinet and pull rope clear of cabinet (This automatically leaves knot inside the cabinet) and toss rope for examination again.

To Reset:- Open top door wide open and pull up on front door and remove it completely and note how fake rope was tacked to fake, tack a new piece and you are set...

Note this box has slots in end as well as holes, thus you may use neck-ties or ribbons as well as ropes... Knowing the working from above effects, you will immediately see how you can work scores of tricks with this cabinet, as it will not only switch center sections of ropes, ribbons and ties, but also switch silks, vanish or produce them...

, A FEW SUGGESTIONS FOR EFFECTS.

Good for the usual cut and restored tie trick, where you have fake center section of a tie in fake, have person planted with duplicate tie and get him up and cut and restore his tie..

OR- Box takes 2 ties as you will see.. Borrow spectators tie (No Plant)

Pandora - Page 2.

Thread that thru the box and to show there are no hard feelings thread your own thru with it..Cut both ties and restore both..

20th. Century Silk Trick With Regular Silks - Stretch A Rope Or Ribbon -

Blendo - RING & RIBBON TRICKS - Switch Regular all differant cards or envelopes threaded on a ribbon for set all alike for many fine spirit effects... Alphabet cards put on floor of cabinet,ribbon strung thru the cabinet and some of cards jump to ribbon to spell a name...

Rope thru cabinet and red silk on floor of cabinet,leaves floor and ends up tied around center of rope..

Borrow a finger ring and apparently whap in a hanky for them to hold, really is left in your hand,as you thread a rope thru cabinet from the rear,thread ring on rope,then open cabinet and they see fake center of rope and no ring..Flip hanky out,ring is gone and appears on center of the rope.

A selected card and blank silk placed in cabinet..When door is opened, card is blank and silk is imprinted with card.

With door up three ribbons are seen thru the box.One selected and other two removed.Selected ribbon is cut and the other two ribbons folded and placed in box..The cut ribbon is restored with the other two ribbons into one lenght of ribbon.Very good with red,white and blue ribbons.

BESIDES:- Use cabinet for any of these effects that requires cabinet to accomplish them..Use cabinet either before or after for any other spirit effect..Such as Milk Lowering In Glass...Spirit Slates.. Etc. Etc.
